On the evening of Aug. 17, first responder Herstle Renfroe suffered an unimaginable tragedy when a structure fire in Parker County claimed the lives of his wife, Alexis Renfroe, and his two sons, 4-year-old Alekzander Joshua Renfroe and 10-year-old Cody Lock Jr.

Herstle has dedicated more than a decade to serving others through fire and emergency medical services, including the past eight years with Sacred Cross EMS, and served as a volunteer firefighter with the Palo Pinto Volunteer Fire Department.

For years, Herstle has answered the call when members of our communities were experiencing some of the worst moments of their lives. Now, our community has an opportunity to answer the call for him.

The MWAN Benevolent Fund for First Responders has been established to provide assistance to first responders and their families following catastrophic events, unexpected tragedies and other significant hardships. Herstle Renfroe is the beneficiary of the fund's first campaign.
